The NSR 10 LED light allows for a rapid cure of large areas and the NSR Stylus light is used to provide necessary light for curing the resin in small, confined areas. NSR150 resin has been optimized for repairing holes and cracks that occur in PVC, CPVC, ABS, polyethylene and other non-metal materials. NSR250 resin has been optimized for repairing holes and cracks that occur in copper, brass, steel, cast iron, black pipe, aluminum and other metal substrates.
